Just in time for Bill Monroe's birthday, the [new single release](#), "A Light in My Window, Again" by [CAROLINA ROAD](#), is now out to radio via [AirplayDirect.com](#). The song was written by Tom T and Dixie Hall and was inspired by Gov. Paul E. Patton's speech at the dedication of the Bill Monroe home place. The tune appears on the band's upcoming album, *BACK TO MY ROOTS* releasing October 11, 2011. CAROLINA ROAD, with eight albums to their credit, has certainly returned to their traditional style of music created over a decade ago with this new project.

*BACK TO MY ROOTS* features new CAROLINA ROAD band member and bluegrass veteran **Tommy Long**. His strong, soulful baritone lead vocals, combined with Lorraine Jordan's tenor vocals, create a wonderful harmony blend that compliments this band's traditional style of music. They are joined by six year CAROLINA ROAD veterans, **Ben Greene** (banjo), **Josh Goforth** (fiddle) and **Eddie Biggerstaff** (bass.)
